SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS

- General Considerations:
 - Use clean, non-breakable, and inert containers that will not contaminate the sample with extraneous material, such as fibers or dust particles.
 - Do not exceed 3/4th the capacity of the container. Use additional containers, if necessary.
 - Seal the container well to prevent spillage of the sample.
 - A Safety Data Sheet or equivalent (Sample Content Form, POL-PC-1.04) must be submitted for each of type material.
- Required amount of samples:
 - Wet Analysis
 - Send 5-10 g of solids or 50-100 mL of concentrated solution (approximately >1% solid)
 - For dilute liquid samples, such as water, send at least 2 L.
 - Dry Analysis
 - Send at least 100 g or 100 cc of solid sample.
